This academic year has been an eventful and whirlwind year filled with excitement and also many challenges. The long school suspension period caused major disruptions to our second term, resulting in the cancellation of many of our PTA events. However, we enjoyed some events during our first term, such as our Christmas Gingerbread Cookies Baking Workshop, Kiddy Cultural Sharing Time, Visit to Po Leung Kuk, Teacher Appreciation Day Celebrations, Parent Seminars, and Special Activity Days. I hope families created some lasting memories during these events and found them enjoyable yet educational.

We experienced some truly difficult times in 2020, so I hereby wish to sincerely thank our parents and teachers for their continuous support and dedication. I am truly grateful for the wonderful community we have built here at CB Victoria. I am indebted to the effort of our PTA Excom members for coming into school in early June to prepare for the return of the K3 students and also organising a spectacular physical graduation ceremony to celebrate our graduates' achievements. We also had a high attendance at our Parent Conferences, and were so moved by the positive feedback from our parents. It was a collective effort that allowed us to make it through such turbulent times.

During the school suspension period we encountered a significant change in our teaching method as our teachers had to switch to e-learning platforms and students engaged in virtual classes and video sessions. The benefits and move towards teaching through technology has long been debated but was undoubtedly accelerated over these past few months. This change has brought about the idea of "Blended Teaching" – a new approach to teaching that combines classroom practices with digitally enhanced strategies.

Finally, in this special year we are also celebrating the 55th anniversary of CB Victoria Kindergarten. To commemorate this occasion, we have designed an anniversary logo that depicts a big hand and a small hand. This symbol is to represent the unity of our Victoria community and the joining of hands through good times and through hardships. To celebrate and mark this milestone, we are planning on hosting a celebratory event on October 9th, 2020 at Ocean Park Marriott Hotel. We look forward to celebrating this important occasion with you all, and hereby I wish everyone an enjoyable summer holiday!

With the pandemic easing off school started to resume in mid June for our K3 students. With the health and safety of our students always being our prime priority the school staff worked hard to implement changes to ensure high hygiene standards are in place prior to school resumption. PTA was invited to attend a campus inspection and we were left feeling very pleased with all the measures that have been arranged.

Here are some examples of the precautionary measures that were made throughout the school premises to ensure social distancing and hygiene standards are upheld:

Class sizes have been reduced by half and plastic panels have been installed to separate each desk. Location stickers have been placed throughout the school to ensure proper social distancing and staff members have taken measures to help good ventilation in different areas. In the toilets you can find labels are used for segregation and identification to ensure toilets are thoroughly cleaned before they are used by other students. Upon entering the school you'll find in the lobby an additional thermal camera thermometer and a sterilising machine!

With all of the measures taken above and more, we are confident and look forward to another year of enjoyable learning in this safe school environment!

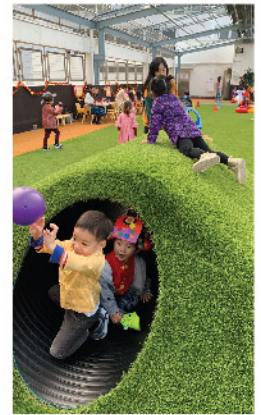

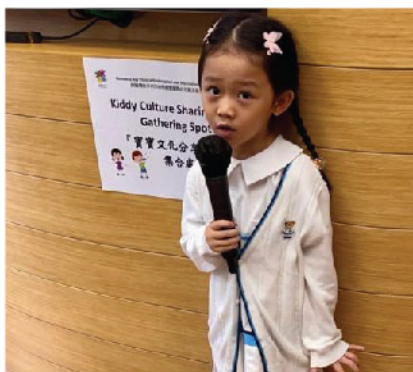
With the goal of providing more learning, public speaking and performance opportunities for our children, we launched the "Kiddy Cultural Sharing Time" program in October and November 2019.

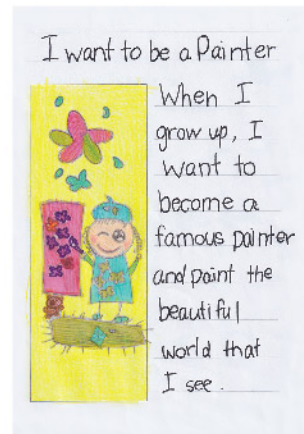
