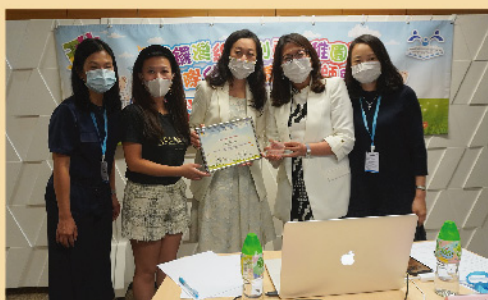

Evidence-based Parenting and Children's Mental Health Webinar

Every parent has their own values and style of parenting. But what is the best way? We were incredibly thankful to Dr. Maggie Koong for inviting Dr. Fanny Wai Fan Lam, founder of the Hong Kong Developmental Paediatrics and Child Neurology Centre, as our guest speaker to discuss the topic of evidence-based parenting and children's mental health.

The first webinar was held at the Hong Kong Developmental Paediatrics and Child Neurology Centre. Dr. Lam explained the importance of the first one-thousand days, reminding us the goal of parenting, that our child is the best manual when it comes to parenting, why we need to help our children feel secure (Circle of Security), importance of rest / exercise / balanced nutrition, how to effectively communicate with our children, help them build resilience and motivate them. In the second webinar, she had an open dialogue with Dr. Maggie Koong at our school. They spent time answering questions from parents from the first webinar as well as discussing SEN (Special Educational Needs), importance of early intervention, spending time with our children to play and to encourage them as well as the topic of speech delays / therapies.

We had an incredible turn out with over 85+ parent participants zooming in. Everyone learned a lot and gained parenting insights through Dr. Lam's talk.

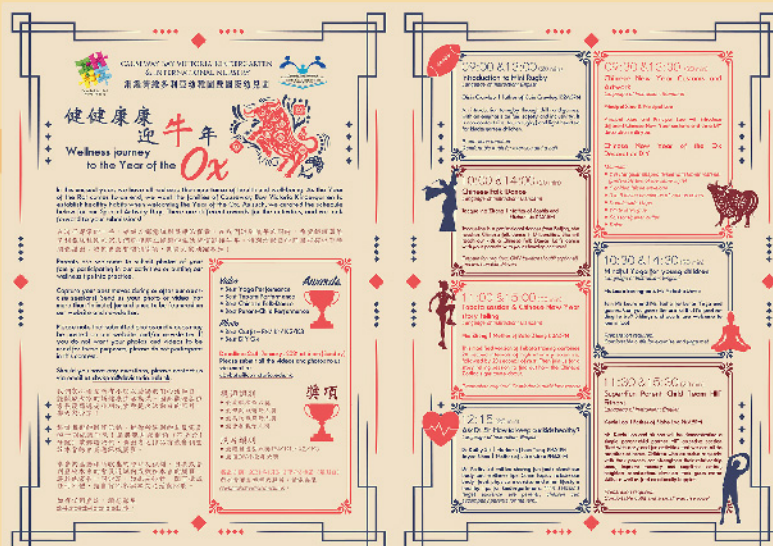

Smart 321 Lunchbox Challenge Online Webinar & The Caring Parents Recipe Book

COVID, COVID, COVID surely made us understand health is of the utmost importance, and the PTA wants to explore the topic of healthy food for our children.

On the evening of 25 May 2021, we held the "Smart 321 Lunchbox Challenge" online webinar led by Flavia U, mother of Hilary Lam (K2A1AMPM). As the Senior Dietitian and Coordinator at Hong Kong Sanatorium & Hospital, Flavia shared her knowledge on topics such as children growth chart and rate, balanced diet and food portion, healthy school lunch boxes and nutrition labeling.

Over 70 families participated in the webinar and actively asked questions during the Q&A. As a follow up on the webinar, parents and children were encouraged to put their learning into practice in our recipe design competition. We have received over 30 submissions and Flavia selected 14 winning recipes to create The Caring Parents Recipe Book with nutrition analysis.

把一個餐盤容量平均分為六格，穀物類佔三格，蔬菜類佔兩格，肉類及代替品佔一格。這樣，穀物類、蔬菜類和肉類及代替品的分量比例便成三比二比一了。





PIKACHU BENTO RECIPE

Ingredients	Amount
Rice	0.5 cup
Egg	1 piece
Quail Egg	2 pieces
Sausage	2 pieces
Lettuce	1 pack
Seaweed	1 pack
Cherry Tomato	2 pieces
Yellow Food Colouring	1 pack

Pikachu's Face: Cook the rice, mix the rice with yellow food colouring, put it flat and put into the lunch box.

Pikachu's Eyes: Cut two circles from the seaweed and place it on Pikachu's face, cut two small pieces from the edge of the quail egg to make the white of the eyes.

Pikachu's Nose and Mouth: Cut small pieces from the seaweed to make the nose and mouth.

Pikachu's Cheeks: Cut two small pieces from the edge of the cherry tomato to make the cheeks.

Pikachu's Ears: Fry the egg and cut into slices, put one slice each on the top of Pikachu's face to make the ears.



Decoration: Put the lettuce around Pikachu's face and place the boiled sausages on the top.

Poké Ball: Cut cherry tomatoes into half, boil the quail eggs and cut them into half; take half of the cherry tomato and half of the quail egg and pin them together with a toothpick in the middle; cut the seaweed and wrap it around the cherry tomato and quail egg to make the Poké Ball belt; cut a small piece from the edge of the quail egg to make the Poké Ball button.

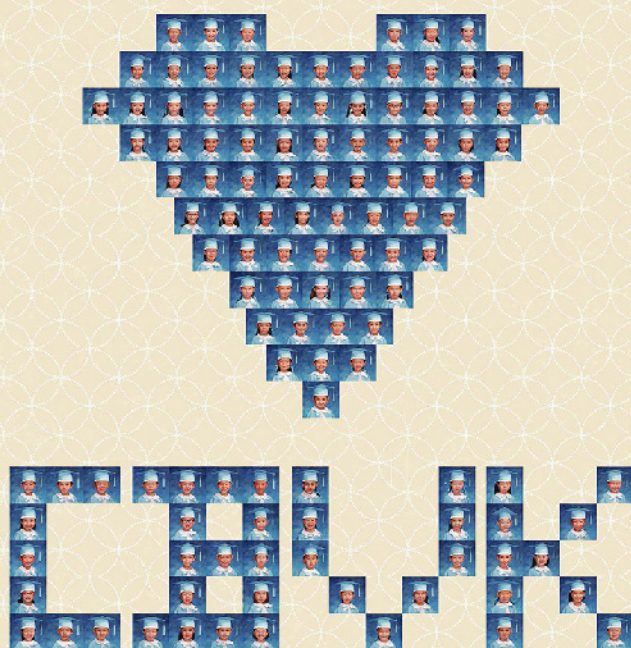
