We kicked off the year with our annual "Teacher Appreciation Day" celebration, 2 charity collaborations with Playright and the necessary PTA meetings. 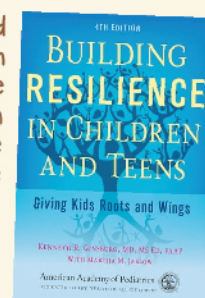
Evidence-based Parenting and Children's Mental Health Webinar

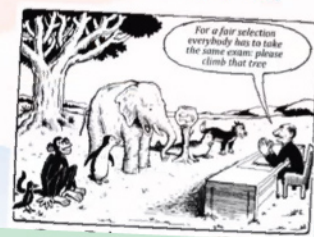
Primary One Interview – Parent Sharing Session Online Webinar

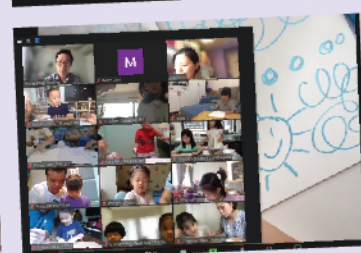
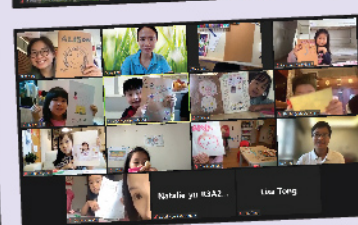
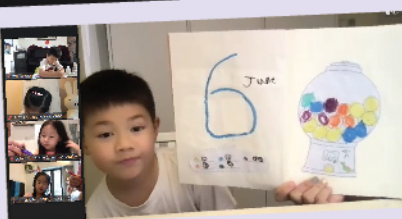
11-12 June 2022

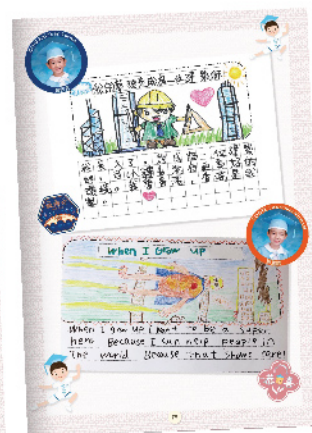
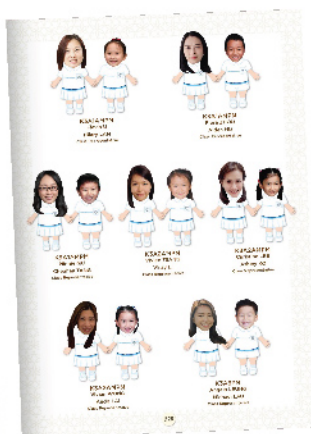
