Message from Dr Maggie KOONG, BBS, JP 總校長孔美琪博士的話



Thank you for yet another eventful year here at CB Victoria Kindergarten. It has been a year full of excitement and challenges, and I hope both our students and parents have finished the year with great memories.

This year, our PTA had organised many activities, beginning in early September 2017 with Teacher Appreciation Day – showcasing their love and appreciation to our teachers. In November, our Mini Rugby Day allowed our students a chance at trying out rugby, taking home with them some basic rugby techniques. In festive celebration of Christmas, our PTA had organised a Christmas Snow Globe Workshop for parents and children to create their very own unique snow globe. The PTA was also regularly present on campus, with their participation in five Special Activity Days themed “Sports Fun”, “People in Our Community”, “Lunar New Year”, “Love Our Earth” and “International Music Party” with the support of many parent volunteers.

Our PTA was also involved in service and community events. These include the PHAB Walkathon, Po Leung Kuk visit, and visit to Chai Wan Police Station, teaching children about their responsibility as a community member and global citizen. Other events included a Mother’s Day Music Box Workshop and a seminar on Primary One Application Process for K2 parents.

The highlight event of the year undoubtedly was the Fukuoka Educational Tour in April. The four-day tour was not only a great opportunity for families to travel and sightsee, but offered plenty of opportunities for cultural exchange and fun-filled parent-child activities. It was an invaluable experience for our children to spend a day with local students and engage in the Japanese learning environment. The highly anticipated trip was a resounding success!

Here at CB Victoria, our core philosophy is to include parents in the school community as our partners and friends. We recognise the importance of developing lasting relationships that transcend through generations. I wish to take this opportunity to personally thank our PTA committee members, including Chairperson Mrs Chiane CHUNG, and Vice Chairpersons, Mrs Jelinda CHAPMAN, and Mrs Ellie LEE. This school year, our school, together with the PTA, arranged a very exciting parent-child educational tour to Fukuoka during our Easter school break. Despite it being only a 4-day trip, we achieved so many things with our children. We set off early on a Wednesday morning, meeting all the participants of the tour to check-in as a group. The children were so excited to see their classmates at the airport! There were more than 80 of us in total - parents, grandparents, our children and their siblings, as well as Dr Maggie KOONG, Principal Sabrina LEE, Head of Admissions Millian SZE, Head Teacher Ms Candy AU and Nurse Ms Rena WANG.

Our first stop was of course, the Fukuoka airport, and Dr KOONG gifted all the children with a toy to play with while waiting for the tour bus. In fact this would be the first treat of many for our kids throughout the next few days, as they were given a variety of toys and snacks. We then headed straight to the hotel and attended a welcome dinner with very enjoyable local performances. The children had a chance to dance and sing with the performers who were dressed in their traditional attire.



The next morning, after a sumptuous breakfast at the hotel, we stopped by the Yukemuri Observatory (別府市別府温泉蒸気展望台) for a beautiful view of this onsen region called Kannawa. We could see the steam wafting up from the onsens scattered throughout the charming scenery. After the Observatory, we went to the Kokonoe Yume Otsurhashi Bridge (九重夢大吊橋) which is the highest and the longest suspension bridge for pedestrians in Japan. A beautiful walk indeed!

Our next stop was the African Safari (日本大分九州自然野生動物園). At the African Safari, the school had arranged an exciting "Jungle Ride" for us so we were able to have a very close encounter with both big and small animals! The children were so excited and perhaps a bit apprehensive at first to feed the carnivores - the meat eaters like lions, tigers and cheetahs, the herbivores like elephants, giraffes and rhinoceros as well as many small animals.

On the way back to the hotel after the Safari, we were able to explore the local village, Kyushu Yufuin Folk Craft Village (九州湯布院民藝). There were arts and crafts as well as food, snacks and souvenirs. We even saw many pretty owls there! Finally, it was time to return to the hotel for another delicious buffet dinner. Many of us took the opportunity to use the onsen at the hotel to relax as well as soothe the aches and tiredness from the long but exciting day.



Day three would prove to be a memorable day with an educational exchange with a local kindergarten, the Daiichi Kindergarten & Nursery. We were welcomed with an impressive Japanese traditional drum performance and the children played some Japanese games together despite not being able to understand each other. We all had great fun!

In the afternoon, we went to the “HAKUHAKU” museum to learn how to make “mentaiko”, the walleye pollack roe! We also took a tour of the museum and saw how their dedicated staff work diligently to make the mentaiko. Then we headed off to the Ohari Park (福岡大濠公園) for a barbecue dinner surrounded by beautiful cherry blossoms (sakura). The children had so much fun with the kites and planes Dr KOONG and Principal LEE surprised them with!



Our last day was also action packed - the children started off the day with a thrilling experience at the Fukuoka City Disaster Prevention Centre (福岡市民防災中心) where they experienced a simulated earthquake, fire and flood. They learnt what to do when there was an earthquake - they said they would need to hide under the table - well done!

After the Fukuoka City Disaster Prevention Centre, we headed off to pick some delicious strawberries at a quaint strawberry farm. We had great fun and ate to our hearts' content as well as pick some to bring home to Hong Kong despite the weather being a little chilly that day. Our last stop before the airport was the Fukuoka Anpanman Children's Museum (福岡麵包超人兒童博物館) where the children had great fun with everything Anpanman (Japanese cartoon character)! It was then time to wrap up this wonderful educational tour as we all headed to the airport, full with happy and beautiful memories of Fukuoka.

As interview time for the private and Direct Subsidy Scheme (DSS) primary schools was approaching, many K2 parents would like to know how they could help their children prepare for the interviews and what they should do throughout the application procedures. It could be a big challenge for the parents to find a suitable school place for their children, particularly for those who were new to this admission system.

In this light, the PTA hosted a seminar on P1 application process on 15 June 2018 and invited five parents who had just gone through the admission games to share their practical experiences with K2 parents. The guest speakers offered insights on how parents could prepare their cover letters and portfolios, and what children were being interviewed with. They also shared the types of activities and games that children might come across during the interviews and how parents and children can prepare in advance in a fun and relaxing way.

It is hard for parents to know exactly what kind of qualities the schools are looking for, but it was agreed that some of the common attributes were: positive, caring and helpful attitude; attentive to teachers' instructions, and most importantly, passionate in reading.

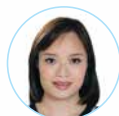
